BOARDS AND COMMITTEES DINNER MEETING

The Moorestown Township Boards and Committees Dinner Meeting commenced at 6:30 p.m. (socializing). At 7:15 p.m., the meeting was called to order by Mayor Gillespie at the Lenola Firehouse, 229 North Lenola Road, Moorestown, New Jersey on December 5, 2022. (See attached Attendance Sheet.)

Mayor Gillespie read the Open Public Meetings Act statement in full as written on the agenda.

Mayor Gillespie asked all to rise for the flag salute. She then asked Patricia Hunt, Township Clerk, to lead the invocation; she did so.

Dinner was served.

At 8:16 p.m., Mayor Gillespie called the meeting back to order. She noted that the year 2020 was a struggle with the pandemic, holding meetings and moving forward, in general and with the use of technology. She commended the boards and committees for the perseverance in moving forward. She expressed her appreciation for the volunteers' service and thanked them on behalf of Council, noting that Council could not do what it does without the support of the boards and committees, indicating the volunteers are second-to-none. Mayor Gillespie introduced Council members and staff that were present. She gave special thanks to Jamie Boren, Lenola Fire House, for use of the venue; Carollos (caterer and decorator); and staff for the organization and presentation of the dinner.

Zoning Board of Adjustment (**Lynne Schill, Vice Chair**)

Comments by Township Council: All members expressed sincere gratefulness to the volunteers, along with their families. Mayor Gillespie noted that in the past three years, Council, accomplished things, including but not limited to, receiving a judgment of compliance with meeting the Township’s affordable housing obligations; purchasing the first piece of open space (p/o of Flying Feather Farm) since 2008; several changes and expansions to the mall, including the Cooper Healthcare center; attaining the “silver” certificate (again) for Sustainable Jersey; compilation of the 10-year Environmental Resource Inventory; website upgrades; the Lenola Town Center Improvements grant and award of a contract; sale of a distribution liquor license; the addition of zoning for microbreweries, a liquor store, cannabis; monthly food truck events at Town Hall, updating the code book, etc. She indicated that all of this was possible because of the volunteers and staff.
